Julie, a normally punctual employee, has shown up late four times in the last two weeks. It is a cool day, but she is sweating. She is usually very social, but today goes right to her workstation and does not talk to anyone. Her movements are very stiff, and she has a difficult time keeping up with her tasks. Her pupils look large. During her break, you engage her in small-talk, and she becomes very irate.
