What Employees Learn:

Whether your employees are experienced drivers, assuming new driving responsibilities, or simply commuting to and from work, this course will provide them with safe driving knowledge and collision prevention strategies that focus on behavior, judgment, decision making and consequences. Offering fact-based data, this course will help influence learners to make positive choices to improve driving behaviors and attitudes and encourage respectful and lawful decisions to avoid collisions and decrease traffic violations.

Focusing behavior-modification strategies and techniques the course now includes greater emphasis on:

- Distracted, fatigued and impaired driving
- Substance impairment
- Sharing the road
- Habits of defensive driving
- Vehicle technology and safety features
- Personal driving behaviors and risk-taking tendencies
- Hazard identification and risk-assessment challenges
- Scenario-based training
- Application of knowledge and skills testing
- Personal plan for making effective driving choices

The 8-hour course provides the highest level of defensive driving knowledge and skills, the benefits of being a safe and responsible driver and the techniques for avoiding high-risk driving behaviors hazard recognition scenarios and skills needed for dealing with immediate danger and anticipating potential hazards are the principal learning points that will have the greatest impact to educate and guide participants to make positive, accountable driving decisions. Participants evaluate their own driving behaviors and develop a personal plan for change. Each participant will receive a student workbook and completion certificate. **The fee to host this program onsite is: \$800 for the first 1–10 students and \$30 for each additional over 10.**

The 4-hour refresher course provides drivers with the basic defensive driving knowledge and techniques through instruction and hazard recognition scenarios. It emphasizes what it means to be a safe and responsible driver and how to cope with high-risk driving situations and behaviors. Each participant will receive a student workbook and completion certificate. **The fee to host this program onsite is: \$700 for the first 1–10 students and \$30 for each additional over 10.**
